

First Aid Provider

The First Aid Provider is responsible for:

- Maintaining a supply of first aid equipment and medical information on campers and staff in accordance with United Church Camping and Alberta Camping Association Standards.
- Meeting with parents and campers at registration to receive medications and health instructions
- Handling all medications and administering proper dosage for staff and campers and for day-to-day first aid concerns and treatment
- In conjunction with the Camp Director, consulting with the cooks regarding allergies
- Ensuring Cabin Counsellors are familiar with any health concerns and medication needs of their campers
- Assisting in maintaining camp safety procedures and practices
- Being an enthusiastic participant in all camp activities whenever possible -- leading campers by example
- Tasks may include, but are not limited to:
 - welcoming campers
 - camp orientation for campers
 - daily chore assignments
 - assisting Program Counsellors with implementation of programs
 - serving meals
 - cleaning cabins

As part of the leadership team, The First Aid Provider must be familiar with camp emergency procedures, and will respect and comply with all camp policies and procedures. All camp staff and campers remain at the campsite during camp, unless permission to leave is granted by the Camp Director. All leadership team members are available to help each other as needed. The First Aid Provider is directly responsible to the Camp Director. This position is deemed to be a level 2 risk assessment with a high level of responsibility and authority for the safety of campers, staff.
